### **Abstract :**

The purpose of this research was to study the opinions of administrators, teachers and students of secondary school was a member of the Long Distance Learning Education programmes, towards the Long Distance Learning programmes of Secondary Education Department Ministry of Education.

The sample of the study were 120 administrators, 240 teachers and 540 students from the first 59 secondary school's member of this programme, 1.239 persons by multiple random sampling.

The instrument for collecting data of this study was the researcher's questionnaires, which multiple choice, 3 level rating scale and open. The Percentage, Arithmetic Mean and Standard Deviation were subsequently employed to analyse the obtained data

The results were as follows:

1. Administrators strongly agree with the planning of the Long Distance Learning Education programmes, agree with the process and the problem of this programme.
2. Teachers agree with the process, the quality of television broadcasts and the problem of the Long Distance Learning Education programmes.
3. Students agree with the quality of television broadcasts of the Long Distance Learning Education programmes.
