Abstract :

The purposes of this study were 1) to investigate the perceptions of students on distant learning management via satellite of Sukhothai Thammathirat University, regarding curriculum, teacher, teaching methods and activities, instructional materials and measurement and evaluation 2) to compare the perception of students on distant learning management via satellite of Sukhothai Thammathirat University, regarding curriculum, teacher, teaching methods and activities, instructional materials and measurement and evaluation classified by gender, status, age, and character of watcher program of distant learning via satellite. The samples were 383 students in bachelor's degree who registered in subject of Thai Education of Sukhothai Thammathirat University which got from classificational random sampling by setting size of the samples at 95 per of percentage convince level according to Yamane formula. The instrument for data collecting was a five-rating scale questionnaire of the perceptions of students on distant learning management via satellite. The satellite used for analyzing the data were percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, one-way analysis of variance and Scheffe' paired test.

The findings were as follow:

1. The perception of students on distant learning management via satellite of Sukhothai Thammathirat University in overall and each aspect was classed at a high level.

2. There was no significant difference between the perceptions of male and female students on distant learning management via satellite of Sukhothai Thammathirat University in overall and each aspect.

3. There was no significant difference among the perceptions of the student who studied in different class levels on distant learning management via satellite of Sukhothai Thammathirat University in overall and each aspect except the aspect of curriculum and instructional materials.

4. There was no significant difference among the perception of students who had different age on distant learning management via satellite of Sukhothai Thammathirat University in overall and each aspect.

5. There was a significant difference among character of students on watching program of distant learning via satellite which there was a significant difference among the perception of students who watched 1/week and 2/week live program as well as who watched reparable program and live program and reparable program.
